Sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Scripture Reflection:

Read the Gospel: Mark 1:40-45

Gospel Summary

In today's gospel, a leper asks Jesus to make him clean, knowing that Jesus has the power to do so. Jesus is moved with pity, reaches out his hand, touches the leper, and heals him. Jesus tells the leper to tell no one, but the leper spreads the news of his healing to all he meets. As a result, many people come to Jesus for healing.

Reflection for Parents

It takes discipline to keep our excitement to ourselves. We tell a close friend and make him or her promise not to tell, but somehow word gets out, and before we know it everyone knows what's going on! In today's gospel, Jesus asks the leper not to share the news of his healing. This invites us to stop and think. Are we good at keeping confidences? Can we wait to share good news until the time is right to do so? A part of being trustworthy is being able to keep things in confidence when we are asked to do so. Why do you think Jesus asked the leper to tell no one of what happened? What happened when the leper told everyone of what happened to him?

Bringing the Gospel into Your Family

Think of people your family knows (or knows about) who are excluded or ignored by others. Maybe there is someone at

school who has a disability, or whose clothes are worn out or dirtier than everyone else's. Maybe there's someone at work whose odd behavior is off-putting. In our communities those who are excluded or ignored might include the homeless, the unemployed, or those in prison, foster homes, or hospitals. As a family, talk about ways you can reach out to the people you name, just as Jesus reached out to the leper. Decide on one action you will take in the coming weeks.

- 3. I would find it hard to keep quiet if...





On the Way - ¡Ándale! Capital Campaign

ext weekend will mark the official start for the *On the Way* - ¡Ándale! Capital Campaign at our parish. This major fundraising effort will address our parish's needs and archdiocesan needs including seed money for the establishment of new parishes in areas of growth, funds in support of the social services Catholic Charities renders to over 230,000 people a year, the establishment of a pilgrimage center at Mission Concepción, support for lay ministry formation, the modernization of Assumption Seminary to support priestly formation,

the renovation of Catholic schools across the archdiocese, and strengthening campus ministry at Texas A&M San Antonio and UTSA.

The preparation phase of the capital campaign began last fall. The archbishop and a leadership team of campaign general chairs have been meeting with major gift donors for the last several months to provide the *On the Way* - ¡Ándale! Capital Campaign with momentum. It is now our turn to continue the great momentum they started.

We will be officially kicking off the *On the Way* - ¡Ándale! Campaign at Masses on August 19 -20. It is an exciting time to be a Catholic in South Central Texas!

Call to Lenten Fast & Abstinence

Lent begins this Wednesday. The following are guidelines for this penitential season. We are asked to respond voluntarily to the call to penance by undertaking some good works and observing certain penitential practices.

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are obligatory days of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. In addition, Fridays during Lent are obligatory days of abstinence.

According to the Church, the norms of fasting are binding for those from age 18 until age 59 who are in good health. When fasting, a person is permitted to eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals that together are not equal to a full meal.

Abstinence refers to the refraining from the eating of meat. The rule of abstinence binds all Catholics 14 years or older. As with Ash Wednesday, Good Friday should be observed as a day of both fasting and abstinence and all Lenten Fridays should likewise be observed as days of abstinence.
