**GOSPEL MEDITATION:
JOHN 6:41-51**

Have you ever approached a hushed group and were certain they were talking about you? It's an uncomfortable feeling to catch people murmuring about what you did, said, or didn't do. It breeds division and exclusion. In today's Gospel, Jesus invites us to just the opposite.

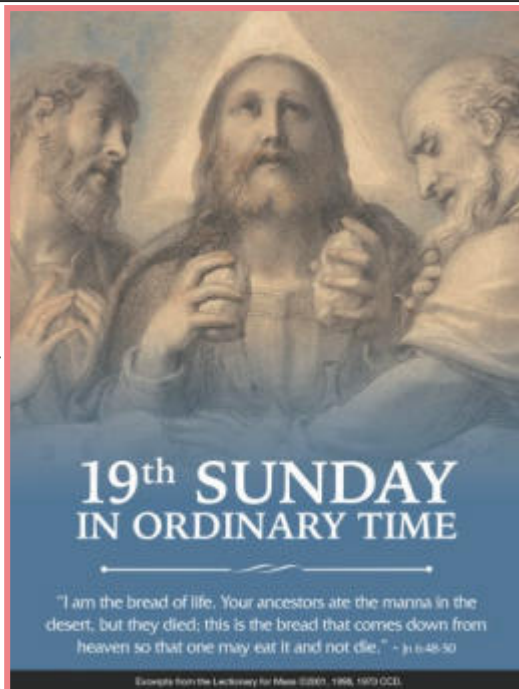
The reading opens with the crowds "murmuring" their doubts about Jesus after he has proclaimed himself the Bread of Life. "Is this not Jesus, the son of Joseph? How can he say 'I have come down from heaven?'" In his response, Jesus brings up the Israelites and the manna God brought them in the desert. If you turn back to the story in Exodus, you'll see another similar word: murmuring. As the going got tough, the Israelites doubted Moses and God's plan to protect and care for them as a chosen people. Here, Jesus proposes a difficult theological concept. Jesus himself is "the living bread" and "flesh for the life of the world."

This is not an exclusive concept. "Everyone who listens to my Father and learns from him comes to me." Why? Because "the Father who sent me draw[s] him." The next time you're at Mass, take a few moments to watch the communion line. Young and old, families and singles, diverse races and cultures and stories—we are all drawn to the Eucharistic table. Catholic doctrine may require faith, but it is a faith possible for anyone who seeks truth. Christianity does not hide behind locked doors in an exclusive clubhouse, whispering behind the backs of nonbelievers. Jesus compels us to share the love of God the Father for his children, that we one day be joined with Him and "live forever."

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Life can be confusing, and the demands and challenges of everyday life can easily cloud our vision. We can become tired. Because of all of the energy needed to manage our day-to-day routines, our spiritual lives can get neglected. Anger, apathy, bitterness, and competition readily distort our relationships with one another and with God. We are asked to imitate God and to put love, compassion, kindness, forgiveness, and gentleness over all things. We need to develop a strong life of prayer in order to bring balance to our lives and to realize who we really are.

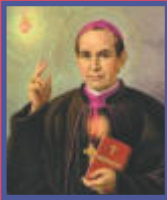

Novena for the Legal Protection of Human Life: Aug. 3— Sept. 28, 2018

Supreme Court Justice Anthony Kennedy's announcement that he will retire has catapulted *Roe v. Wade* (the Supreme Court's landmark abortion case) into the news. Pro-abortion groups are pulling out all the stops to urge the U.S. Senate to reject any nominee who does not promise to publicly endorse *Roe*. And they are misrepresenting the legal and social reality of *Roe* and what would happen if it is overturned.

The upcoming Supreme Court vacancy provides us with yet another occasion requiring focused prayer. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops does not support or oppose the confirmation of any presidential nominee. However, given this historic moment, the U.S. bishops are urging all people of good will to pray that a change in the U.S. Supreme Court may move our nation closer to the day when every human being is protected in law and welcomed in life.

If *Roe* is overturned, the democratic process—not the courts—will determine abortion policy.

Before *Roe*, all states permitted abortion if necessary to save the mother's life, and some permitted abortion in additional circumstances.¹ But *Roe* deemed any prohibition on abortion as unconstitutional.

If *Roe* is overturned, policy decisions about abortion will be made by the citizens of each state through the democratic process, rather than by courts. Some states will place limits on abortion, in others there will likely be few limits.²

Not until *Roe v. Wade* is reversed will the people again be able to govern themselves on the important public policy issue of abortion.

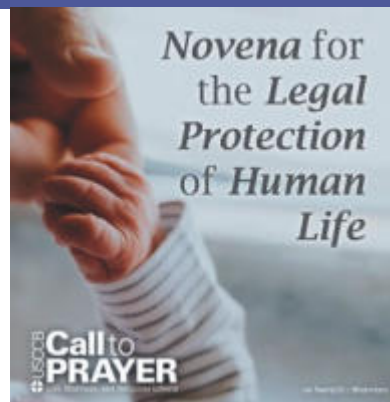

Preparation for Confirmation is a three-year process, beginning in 9th grade.

PARENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Attend Mass **EVERY** Saturday or Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation.
- Participate in ALL orientations and parent conferences.
- Parents of third-year Confirmation students must attend the Sacramental Parent Class in the second week of each month during the same session that their child attends.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Must attend Mass EVERY Saturday or Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation. Students will be required to keep a Mass journal **all three years.**
- Must attend religious education class regularly. Only three unexcused absences are allowed. Failure to attend may result in repeat of the grade or delay in receiving the sacrament.
- Must attend **ALL** retreats. Missing these or failing to attend Mass may result in a delay of reception of the sacrament.
- Community service hours are required **all three years.**
- First-year students will be required to obtain a sponsor who is in **good standing with the Church** and **will mentor them through this process.**
- Second-year students will be asked to research saints in order to choose a patron saint for their guidance. They will be required to turn in a report and present it in class.

First Holy Communion & Reconciliation Requirements

Preparation for Reconciliation /First Holy Communion is a two-year process. Formal instruction usually begins in 1st grade and concludes in 2nd grade.

Both sacraments take place the second year.

PARENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Attend Mass **EVERY** Saturday or Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation.
- Encourage an active family prayer life.
- Participate in **ALL** mandatory conferences: two parent conferences the second year.
- Ensure your child is mastering required prayers (outlined by grade online).
- Parents of the second-year students must attend the Sacramental Parent Class in the second week of each month during the same session that their child attends.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Must attend Mass **EVERY** Saturday or Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation.
- Must attend religious education class regularly. Only three unexcused absences are allowed. Failure to attend may result in repeat of the grade or delay in receiving the Sacraments.
- Must attend **ALL** three Reconciliation retreats.

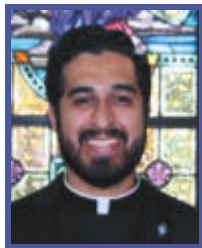
