

21st Sunday in Ordinary Time

GOSPEL MEDITATION: JOHN 6:60-69

"This saying is hard; who can accept it?" The words of Jesus' disciples in today's Gospel must sound familiar. At some point in our lives, you and I have said it about some article of our faith. Christianity makes firm demands on our ethical behavior and gives no easy answers for suffering. Many disciples were confused and dismayed by Jesus' words in the Bread of Life Discourse. Not all of them, however, had the same reaction.

When the disciples question Jesus' teaching, he confirms its truth. "The words I have spoken to you are spirit and life." For some, Jesus' reassurance was not enough. These disciples do not question Jesus further or wrestle with their lack of understanding. The mighty deeds Jesus has done fade to the background. "Many of his disciples returned to their former way of life and no longer accompanied him." For them, their doubt proves too much.



Jesus turns to the Twelve, knowing that confusion lives in their hearts as well. Peter answers. "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." Notice this is not a confession of perfect understanding. It is a confession of faith in Jesus. The precise words may still confuse them, but they believe the One who said them.

In our own lives, we face doubt, confusion, and disillusionment in our Christian faith. The same choice available to the disciples is available to us. Do you have faith in Jesus, even when you lack perfect understanding? Will you stay or will you go? What do you do with your doubt?

LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Jesus' teaching is hard and challenging. In fact, many who originally believed in him left and returned to their former way of life. They were not able to accept what he had to say or to make the changes that are necessary to conform their lives to the Gospel. We often water down our faith and make it more about securing our place in heaven than leading a life in pursuit of the kingdom of God. Following Jesus and living the Gospel require action now. The Gospel demands that we change the way we conduct the business of our lives. Sadly, many are still afraid of taking risks and cannot accept change. Are we really ready to venture forth into the unknown, or would we prefer to simply return to our old ways of doing things?





Our inaugural program has been a big success and we are currently *halfway* through the list of families who signed up.



REGISTRATION ENDS SOON!

Registration for RE classes grades 1-12 & youth sacramental preparation classes: \$35 per child after all weekend Masses or weekdays August 19 - 31, 9 a.m. - 6 p.m.

All registration will take place in the RE building.

First-time families (specifically sacramental students) MUST bring a copy of the child's baptismal certificate.

Sessions available on a first-come, first-served basis until full:

- Sunday 8:30 9:45 a.m. (attending 10 a.m. Mass): grades 1-8 ONLY
- Sunday 10:30 11:45 a.m. (attending 12 p.m. Mass): grades 1-8 ONLY
- Sunday 4:30 5:45 p.m.: high school Confirmation ONLY
- Wednesday 5:15 6:15 p.m.: grades 1-8 only
- Wednesday 6:45 7:45 p.m.: grades 1-8 & high school Confirmation classes



PARENTS: PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING VERY IMPORTANT SACRAMENTAL REQUIREMENTS

Confirmation Requirements

Preparation is a three-year process, beginning in 9th grade.

PARENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Attend Mass EVERY Saturday or Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation.
- Participate in ALL orientations and parent conferences.
- Parents of third-year Confirmation students must attend the Sacramental Parent Class in the second week of each month during the same session that their child attends.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Must attend Mass EVERY Saturday or Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation. Students will be required to keep a Mass journal all three years.
- Must attend religious education class regularly. Only three unexcused absences are allowed. Failure to attend may result in repeat of the grade or delay in receiving the sacrament.
- Must attend ALL retreats. Missing these or failing to attend Mass may result in a delay of reception of the sacrament.
- Community service hours are required all three years.
- First-year students will be required to obtain a sponsor who is in good standing with the Church and will mentor them through this process.
- Second-year students will be asked to research saints in order to choose a patron saint for their guidance. They will be required to turn in a report and present it in class.

First Holy Communion & **Reconciliation Requirements**

Preparation for Reconciliation /First Holy Communion is a twoyear process. Formal instruction usually begins in 1st grade and concludes in 2nd grade. Both sacraments take place the second year.

PARENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Attend Mass **EVERY** Saturday or Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation.
- Encourage an active family prayer life.
- Participate in ALL mandatory conferences: two parent conferences the second year.
- Ensure your child is mastering required prayers (outlined by grade online).
- Parents of the second-year students must attend the Sacramental Parent Class in the second week of each month during the same session that their child attends.

STUDENT REQUIREMENTS:

- Must attend Mass EVERY Saturday or Sunday and all Holy Days of Obligation.
- Must attend religious education class regularly. Only three unexcused absences are allowed. Failure to attend may result in repeat of the grade or delay in receiving the Sacraments.
- Must attend ALL three Reconciliation retreats.
