



#### Parish Mission Statement.

#### **GOSPEL MEDITATION: LK 1:1-4; 4:14-21**

"He came to Nazareth, where he had grown up." Did you grow up in a small town? Whenever you see stories of tight-knit communities, a common refrain is that everybody knows everybody and that's very difficult to change. If you leave and return, people expect you to be and act a certain way, and it's strange for them if you do not. In today's Gospel, we see that Jesus was already moving "in the power of the Spirit and news of him spread throughout the whole region. He...was praised by all." His ministry has begun! News of his growing popularity must have proceeded him to Nazareth.

Upon his arrival, he "went according to his custom into the synagogue on the sabbath day." For the first few moments, he is what they expect - their hometown boy returning to pay his respects. As was common of men at the time, he takes a turn reading a passage of Sacred Scripture. It is a bold passage, one he selects intentionally. "He unrolled the scroll and found the

passage where it was written: The Spirit of the Lord is upon me." After reading about holy anointings, liberation for the poor and prisoners, and physical healings, Jesus does the unthinkable. "'Today this Scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing."

We are all called to imitate Christ wherever we are. This might mean doing the unexpected! All too often we're content with the daily status quo, and so are the people around us. When we take a stand for Christian values, change our lifestyle to reflect the Gospel, and work for





# FROM THE ARCHBISHOP'S OFFICE

# Department of Communication Archdiocese of San Antonio

On January 31, Archbishop Gustavo García-Siller, MSpS, will share a report of child sexual abuse by clergy in the Archdiocese of San Antonio with the people of our parishes. With this report, the Archdiocese of San Antonio will present a transparent account of clergy sexual abuse of children in our local church from 1940 to the present. Archbishop Gustavo, with this report, will express regret and apologizes for the failings and sins that have hurt the Church so deeply, especially in our most vulnerable members. He will especially ask forgiveness for the failings of those who have held positions of leadership in the Church. After much prayerful discernment, and bearing consciously the burden of anger and shame accumulated over the last 75 years, the Archdiocese makes this report praying that those who are suffering will be able to hear this as a sincere apology.

After 2 p.m. on January 31, the report will be immediately available on the webpage of the archdiocese at archsa.org.


