

Fifth Sunday in Ordinary Time

#### GOSPEL MEDITATION: LK 5:1-11

Do you have enough? Many of us come from a nation of material abundance. We have all the things we could possibly need not only to survive, but to thrive—food, shelter, mental ability, income, access to medical care. Most people in human history lived with far less than we. So why are we so dissatisfied? Some Christians can be drawn to the "prosperity Gospel." This is the idea that following God will bring us material abundance in this life.

That surely seems to be the story of today's Gospel! Peter and his friends chose —with some faith—to put out their nets a final time at Jesus' command. "They caught a great number of fish and their nets were tearing. They signaled to their partners in the other boat to come to help

them. They came and filled both boats so that they were in danger of sinking." What gift! What abundance! What prosperity! Peter and his friends caught more fish than they'd ever seen. Yet what is their response to this material abundance, this gift from God? They leave it behind. "When they brought their boats to the shore, they left everything and followed him."

Praying for God to meet our physical, material needs is not a bad thing! Jesus himself includes "give us this day our daily bread" in the prayer he teaches his disciples. The question is, how do we respond when our prayers are answered? Do we thank God briefly, or perhaps



ignore Him completely and move on with our lives? Or do we respond as Peter did? "God, You showed up in an area that has no bearing on my eternal salvation. You gave me a gift I didn't even really need. You love me! You really do love me." Is our gratitude only surface level? Or do we allow ourselves, like Peter did, to respond with wonder, awe, and deeper discipleship?

#### LIVE THE LITURGY - INSPIRATION FOR THE WEEK

Have you ever felt a compelling urge to respond to a situation and then found yourself questioning whether you should do so? Fear often takes hold of us, and we find ourselves making excuses for why it is better to just mind our own business. There is a voice within each of us that is saying, "Follow me." What does this prompting mean? The purpose of discipleship is not to secure our own station in life and enhance our comfort zone. Discipleship is about taking risks and venturing forth into the unknown, tending to the needs of others and being prophetic voices of change. We will not drink deeply of life until we listen to the voice of God within. When God asks, "Whom shall I send?" will you reply, "Here I am! Send me!"? -Tracy Earl Welliver, MTS

#### Married Love and the Gift of Life

A teaching statement by the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) approved for publication by the full body of bishops at its November 2006 General Meeting. An excerpt:

In the *Rite of Marriage* (1969) a man and woman are asked if they will love one another faithfully and totally—in short, if they will love as God loves. "Have you come here freely and without reservation to give yourselves to each other in marriage?" asks the bishop, priest, or deacon. "Will you love and honor each other as man and wife for the rest of your lives? Will you accept children lovingly from God, and bring them up according to the law of Christ and his Church?" These are different ways of asking the same basic question: Are you ready to accept this person, and all that may come from your union, completely and forever? The spouses seal their love and commitment through their sexual

union. Many today find it difficult to understand how profound and meaningful this union is, how it embodies these promises of marriage. Our culture often presents sex as merely recreational, not as a deeply personal or even important encounter between spouses. In this view, being responsible about sex simply means limiting its consequences—avoiding disease and using contraceptives to prevent pregnancy.

This cultural view is impoverished, even sad. It fails to account for the true needs and deepest desires of men and women. Living in accord with this view has caused much loneliness and many broken hearts.

God's plan for married life and love is far richer and more fulfilling. Here sexuality is the source of a joy and pleasure that helps the spouses give themselves to each other completely and for their entire lives. (Visit www.usccb.org for more info.)

#### El Amor Matrimonial y el Don de la Vida

En el Ritual de Matrimonio (1969) se pregunta, al hombre y a la mujer, si se amarán fiel y plenamente — es decir, si amarán como ama Dios. "¿Han venido aquí a contraer matrimonio por su libre y plena voluntad y sin que nada ni nadie los presione?", pregunta el obispo, el sacerdote, o el diácono. "¿Están dispuestos a amarse y honrarse mutuamente en su matrimonio durante toda la vida? ¿Están dispuestos a recibir con amor los hijos que Dios les dé, y a educarlos según la ley de Cristo y de su Iglesia?" Todas ellas son diferentes maneras de formular la misma pregunta esencial: ¿Estás listo para aceptar a esta persona, y todo lo que puede producir esta unión, completamente y para siempre?

Los esposos sellan su amor y su compromiso mediante su unión sexual. Hoy en día es dificil, para muchos, comprender qué profunda y significativa es esta unión, cómo encarna estas promesas del matrimonio. Nuestra cultura a menudo presenta el sexo como una mera recreación, no como un encuentro profundo e importante entre esposos. Según esa opinión, ser responsable sexualmente significa simplemente limitar las consecuencias — evitar las enfermedades y utilizar anticonceptivos para impedir embarazos.

Éste es un enfoque cultural empobrecido, y hasta triste. No da cuenta de las verdaderas necesidades y de los deseos más profundos de los hombres y las mujeres. La aceptación de este enfoque ha causado gran soledad y sufrimiento. El plan de Dios para la vida y el amor matrimonial es mucho más rico y más satisfactorio. En él la sexualidad es una fuente de dicha y placer, que ayuda a que los esposos se entreguen el uno al otro, plenamente, durante toda la vida. (El sitio de los obispos: www.usccb.org)


