GOSPEL MEDITATION: MT 14:22-33

Be still and know that I am God. Silence is sacred. Silence speaks the language of the soul and is the foundation of all life and eternity itself. Silence takes us beyond the limits of our minds and allows us to seek and to love the essence of all love, perfect love, and being. In silence, we can be non-verbally present to things and to God in ways that words cannot accomplish. We can discover, encounter, and be present to truths that our minds struggle to conceive and then set aside the boxes we put around things when comprehending them is challenging. We can know the unknowable and touch eternity when we encounter the core silence in our souls.

We can do this even on a noisy street and in the midst of the greatest distraction. Once we have made friends with silence, the rambling noise of the world no longer seems to matter, and we can carry a deep forgiving peace within us, even when physical silence cannot be found. We know that we are loved, cared for, sustained, nourished, embraced, and carried. There is nothing to fear in silence, and I can be present to myself in the same way that God is present to me. I can see myself as God sees me. All of my faults, weaknesses, imperfections, failings, and sinfulness melt away in the

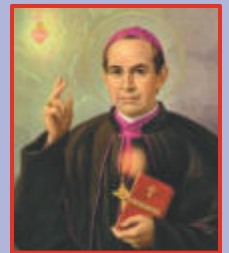

abundance of God's mercy. All of the worldly things we see as being important no longer are.

It is in silence that all of the barriers that divide us disappear. There is no more "yours" and "mine" but only the oneness of "ours." There is no longer a need to "figure things out," and we tap into our desire to simply let things be. Silence is creative and powerful and gives us hope. Silence is God's greatest blessing. God became one with humanity in silence. It allows us to be one with all of creation, with the moon and the stars and all of the creatures God has made. The smallest particle of creation radiates with beauty. Silence allows us to soar beyond ourselves and connect in ways that the mind can only imagine. When all is quiet, we begin to see that it is only our fear that keeps us from the Lord. It is our fear that causes us to sink and to fail. We can hear the gentle whisper that tells us to reach for God's hand. We discover that we yearn for the salvation and wholeness that only God can give to us. Be still my soul and be at peace.

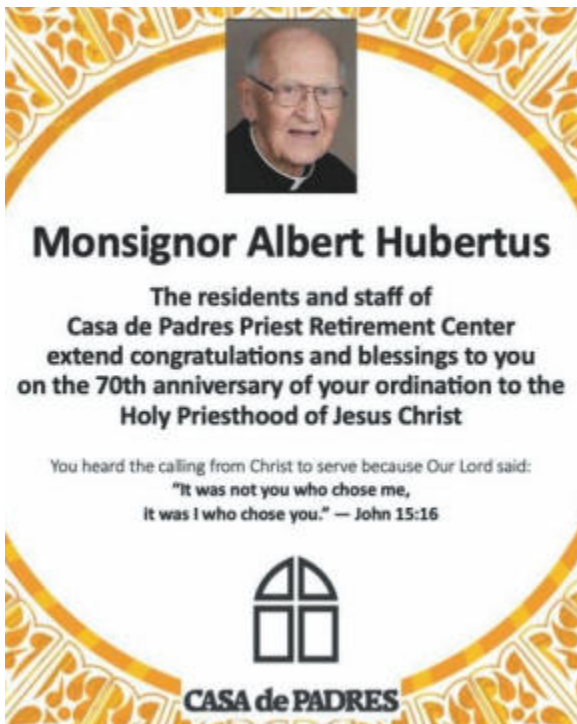

Join our parish Knights of Columbus in congratulating our founding pastor Monsignor Albert Hubertus on the 70th Anniversary of ordination to the Holy Priesthood of Jesus Christ!

Msgr. Hubertus founded St. Anthony Mary Claret Church on July 9, 1988. One of his first actions was to establish Knights of Columbus Council 10090. With his help, it grew, establishing multiple corporal charitable and spiritual works that remain its focus to this day.

At age 94, Msgr. Hubertus' motivational and spiritual prayers during council meetings motivated the men to put in over 6,839 hours and \$16,078 in charitable donations towards Faith in Action programs. During one of its meetings, Msgr. Hubertus said he was elated "to see that St. Anthony Mary Claret's Knights of Columbus Council #10090 is still continuing to grow and prosper since its inception in 1988" and that "the

council's fraternal family is now composed of both older and younger generation Brother Knights." He also emphasized that "it is the duty of the older generation to provide their wisdom to the younger generation. However, it is the duty of the younger generation to show their enthusiasm and support for the parish and the church to the older generation. Ultimately, it is the duty of both generations to dedicate themselves to the welfare of the church."

Msgr. Hubertus keeps active and would celebrate Mass every Thursday for the Benedictine Sisters in Boerne. He remains a strong advocate of Catholic families and the Knights of Columbus Order.

Mass Attendance Guidelines*

Archbishop Gustavo's dispensation of Catholics from the obligation to participate in Sunday and Holy Days of Obligation Masses within the Archdiocese of San Antonio granted on March 13, 2020 is in effect until repealed. At-risk people or those with symptoms of the common cold, flu or Covid-19 should stay home.

Mass Participation, attendance & seating

- Masks will be required for all persons over age 10.
- No missalette, song books, or prayer aids will be available.
- There will be no exchange of peace by handshake or hug.
- Attendance will be limited to 50% of our normal capacity.
- Mass will be held in the main sanctuary. Overflow livestreamed in Msgr. Hubertus Hall. Sacramental Communion offered in both locations.
- Hospitality team members will seat you at least six feet apart from others. Family members may sit together without separation.
- Hospitality team members will escort you from church immediately after Mass.

Communion

- The Sacred Body of Christ will be distributed in the hand only, not on the tongue.
- After the Eucharistic Minister has placed the Sacred Body of Christ in your hand, lower your mask and consume the Body of Christ, re-mask and return to your seat.
- The Precious Blood of Christ will not be distributed.

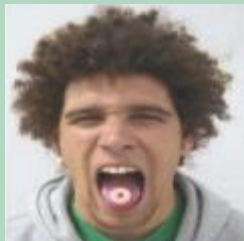
