## GOSPEL MEDITATION: MK 16:15-20

Justice is about setting relationships right because we are all filled with God's love and have dignity. It is a story that does not end with the Cross or even the Resurrection. The story finds its happy ending in the Ascension. Our human narrative is still evolving and moving ever more closely toward that day when all will be one in Christ.







#### ARCHDIOCESAN DECREE: REINSTATEMENT OF SUNDAY MASS OBLIGATION

The Reinstatement of the Sunday Mass Obligation

May 05, 2021

My Beloved Brothers and Sisters in Christ,





It is through the Eucharist, the source and summit of our faith, that we are sustained with the lifegiving nourishment of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. Due to the essential spiritual need we have for weekly physical participation in Sunday Mass, the tremendous gift and spiritual nourishment of physically receiving our Lord in Holy Communion is critically important for our spiritual growth and is very much needed right now.

Therefore, in consultation with various officials, and in light of the increasing number of individuals having received the COVID-19 vaccine, I believe now is the appropriate time to remove the dispensation previously granted to Catholics on March 13, 2020, from the obligation to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation. I revoke the dispensation I granted on March 13, 2020. Therefore, effective May 23, 2021, the Solemnity of Pentecost, the obligation for Catholics to attend Sunday Mass and Holy Days of Obligation is reinstated for all Catholics in the Archdiocese of San Antonio.

For Catholics who have serious reasons for not physically attending Mass, I encourage you to follow the guidance the Church provides in the Catechism of the Catholic Church (2181): "The Sunday Eucharist is the foundation and confirmation of all Christian practice. For this reason the faithful are obliged to participate in the Eucharist on days of obligation, unless excused for a serious reason (for example, illness, the care of infants) or dispensed by their own pastor." Other examples are the elderly and physically disabled persons and those with compromised immune systems who have prayerfully discerned that they should not physically attend.

The protocols issued earlier remain in effect for those attending Mass, namely: wear a face mask before entering the Church and throughout the Mass, use hand sanitizer before receiving Communion, maintain three feet of space between you and others, follow instructions of ushers, as you enter and leave the Church, and receive Holy Communion in the hand and not on the tongue.

As Catholics, we gladly return to the altar of God to receive the Bread of Life from the One who gives healing and joy to our hearts.

Revoco la dispensa que concedí el 13 de marzo de 2020. Por lo tanto, a partir del 23 de mayo de 2021, Solemnidad de Pentecostés, se restablece para todos los católicos en la Arquidiócesis de San Antonio la obligación de asistir a misa los domingos y los días santos de precepto.

A los católicos que tienen serias razones para no asistir fisicamente a misa los animo a seguir la guía que la Iglesia proporciona en el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica (2181): "La Eucaristía del domingo fundamenta y confirma toda la práctica cristiana. Por eso los fieles están obligados a participar en la Eucaristía los días de precepto, a no ser que estén excusados por una razón seria (por ejemplo, enfermedad, el cuidado de niños pequeños) o dispensados por su pastor propio". Otros ejemplos son los ancianos y las personas con discapacidades físicas, así como quienes tienen sistemas inmunitarios comprometidos y que han discernido en oración que no deberían asistir físicamente.

Los protocolos emitidos anteriormente siguen vigentes para quienes asisten a misa, a saber: utilizar una mascarilla desde antes de ingresar a la iglesia y durante la misa, usar desinfectante de manos antes de recibir la Comunión, mantener un espacio de tres pies entre uno mismo y los demás, seguir las instrucciones de los ujieres al entrar y salir de la iglesia, y recibir la Sagrada Comunión en la mano y no en la lengua.
