GOSPEL MEDITATION:

LK 4:1-13


One of the greatest temptations human beings face is leaving the truth of who they are, where they came from and who created them in pursuit of more personal satisfactions. When we consider all that desires our attention in a given day, there are many lures that attract us to illusions about ourselves. We can easily find ourselves distracted or tired, preoccupied with preserving our status in life, social relationships, current trends, and corporate demands, and intrigued by pursuing what we perceive to be the "path of least resistance." The daily concerns of life can quickly take our eyes off of our truth, making the empty promises of worldly accomplishments and ideologies seem so attractive. What is at risk in giving into this temptation?

We cease giving thanks to and worshipping our Creator as we pursue our own self-sufficiency, power, and prestige. We replace the true God with a "pet" one.

While many do not totally dismiss the idea of God and pretend to remain at least remotely connected, they do not invest themselves heart, mind, and soul in the relationship either. That is why we are so easily swayed. If something attractive comes along, we lunge for it. After all, having a position above and over everyone else is a good thing, isn't it? In more honest moments, many have to admit that they believe this to be true. The Evil One is very convincing. But he can only gain control if we allow him to.

About temptation, St. Basil remarks, "As the pilot of a vessel is tried in the storm, as the wrestler is tried in the ring, the soldier in the battle and the hero in adversity, so is the Christian tried in temptation." And here is found the reason for Lent. It is a wonderful





**A Lenten Journey in the Gospel of Luke
The Church: Praying, Fasting and Giving Alms
Presenter: Most Reverend Michael J. Boulette, D.Min.**



Monday, March 7, 7 PM - *“Lord, teach us to pray...”* — Luke 11:1

It is a serious question why the disciples, faithful Jewish folks, needed to be taught to pray at all. Indeed they did, for there is a distinct way of prayer for the Christian disciple. We will first explore material from the Old Testament book of Nehemiah on Old Testament prayer and then move to a discussion of the meaning of the Lord’s Prayer.

Tuesday, March 8, 7 PM - *“I will break away and return to my father...”* — Luke 15:18a

This night we will examine in depth the story of the “Prodigal Son” and the nature of true reconciliation. It will reveal to us the desire of our God to forgive us and will enlighten us about just who is the real “prodigal” One. We will explore in detail the path of reconciliation.

Wednesday, March 9, 7 PM - *“Do this in remembrance of me.”* — Luke 22:19b

The stories of the origins of the Eucharist are truly important to us. The Eucharist is the place of reconciliation and nourishment for Luke. We will examine various meals at which Jesus ate in order to understand something of the fullness of this great sacrament for the Church.

BRING YOUR BIBLE! All presentations to be held in the church.

Born in Hudson Falls, New York, to French Canadian and Italian parents, Bishop Mike Boulette moved with his family to Fredericksburg, Texas at the age of nine. Called to the priesthood, he took his formation through Roman Catholic seminaries in the Archdiocese of San Antonio. He subsequently completed a Master of Theology degree at the University of Notre Dame in South Bend, Indiana. He also received Bachelor’s and Master’s degrees in Psychology from St. Mary and Trinity Universities in San Antonio, and a Doctor of Ministry degree in Preaching and Worship from Austin Presbyterian Theological Seminary in Austin, Texas.

He has served in pastoral ministry since 1976, with nine years as Director of Spiritual Formation at Assumption Seminary in San Antonio, and a total of 18 years as Pastor and Administrator at Notre Dame Catholic Church and School in Kerrville.

In 2004, he was commissioned to begin a new ministry for the Archdiocese of San Antonio, which was named St. Peter Upon the Water: A Center for Spiritual Direction and Formation. It is a place where people may find spiritual direction and a formation program for spiritual directors, also providing writings about spiritual issues and speakers for parish retreats and missions. In 2017, he accepted the call to become Auxiliary Bishop for the Archdiocese of San Antonio. He presently serves as Vicar General to the Archbishop and Moderator of the Curia to the Archbishop’s staff.




