	A.	Be a graduating high school senior.			
	B.	Be a practicing member of Saint Anthony Mary Claret Catholic Church.			
	C.	Have received or are preparing to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation.*			
		* You MUST provide a COPY of your Confirmation certificate or proof of enrollment in Confirmation classes <u>ONLY IF</u> you were not Confirmed here at Saint Anthony Mary Claret or have not or are not attending classes for the preparation for Confirmation here at Saint Anthony Mary Claret. DO NOT SEND ORIGINALS.			
	D.	Have participated in documented service to the parish (or Catholic school, if applicable).			
	E.	Have a GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) or higher.			
	F.	Be entering a continuing education program such as college, trade school, internship, etc.			
	G.	Submit a completed Saint Anthony Mary Claret Scholarship Application Form.			
	Н.	Submit an official Transcript. It must be issued by an appropriate school official, bearing a certification seal and placed in a sealed envelope. The High School Transcript must be issued March 1, 2023 or thereafter.			
	I.	Submit three Character Profile forms from <i>non-relatives</i> , <u>two of whom must be members of Saint Anthony Mary Claret Parish</u> (excluding the pastor, immediate members of your own family, and members of the Scholarship Awards Committee). Letters of recommendation <u>ARE NOT</u> acceptable substitutes for these forms.			
	J.	Submit a <u>typed, double-spaced</u> essay (maximum two pages). Staple the pages together. Attention and care should be given to composition , punctuation , and grammar. The essay must address ALL of the <u>following</u> :			
		 Tell us about yourself and your family. What involvement have you had in Holy Gospel-inspired activities, whether here at Saint Anthony Mary Claret parish or elsewhere? (If elsewhere, name the location.) Some examples include youth group, altar servers, catechesis, Saint Anthony Claret Pantry, homeless ministry, etc. Discuss a <i>minimum of three</i>. 			

- ministry, etc. <u>Discuss a minimum of three</u>.What career are you pursuing and how did you reach this decision?What contributions have you made to your own family, our parish, and the community?

- II. Applications will be disqualified for the following reasons:
 - A. Failure to meet *any* of the application criteria (see Section I, letters A J).
 - B. Incomplete or incorrect application (see Section I, letters C, G, H, I, J).
 - C. Failure to address specified topics in the essay (see Section I, J).
 - D. Unacceptable delivery method; failure to meet postmark deadline (see Section III).
 - E. False or misleading information.
- III. Method of submission must be as follows:
 - A. Application packet must be sent by U.S. mail or other authorized carrier (e.g., Federal Express, UPS, etc.). *Absolutely no hand-delivered or e-mailed applications will be accepted*.
 - B. It must be *postmarked by Friday*, *April 28*, 2023.

- IV. Awarding of scholarships will take place as follows:
 - A. Applications will be reviewed by a committee consisting of representatives from each of the awarding parish organizations, one member of the parish Pastoral Council and one member of the parish staff.
 - B. All winners will be announced and given a confirmation certificate at a Mass the first weekend of June 2023.
 - C. Scholarship proceeds will be made payable to the student and made available the first week of August, 2023, pending receipt of proof of enrollment which must be received in the parish office prior to payment being made.

VERY IMPORTANT: <u>It is the student's or the student's parents' responsibility to come into the parish office to claim his or her check. The check will be given only AFTER proof of actual enrollment has been provided to the parish office.</u>
