

#### GOSPEL MEDITATION: MK 14:1—15:47

A few months before they married, my twenty-three-year-old sister and her fiancé planned a cross-country road trip to visit his family. My parents told them that they could only go if they slept in separate hotel rooms, offering to foot the bill. It might sound prudish, but my parents wanted the young couple to understand that their approaching unity was close, but not yet. Patience solidifies love.

What could this possibly have to do with Palm Sunday? It's usually overlooked, but the Gospels tell us that, after entering Jerusalem, Jesus "looked around ... and since it was late, went out to Bethany with the twelve" (Mk 11:11) for the night. Who cares? Why include this detail? Jews in those days believed that the new Davidic King




would one day re-enter and "marry" the city. A new future marked by fidelity would begin for God's people. Israel's God would be in union with His people forever. Without over-sexualizing the metaphor, perhaps Jesus refused to sleep in Jerusalem to remind us of his marital purpose. He was entering Jerusalem as the bridegroom-king. It was almost time, but not yet. Soon he will sleep in Jerusalem in the tomb and then something new will begin: his one body, his Church.

Lenten challenge: This Holy Week, I challenge you to keep this image in your mind all the way until Easter Sunday: Jesus is the faithful bridegroom who patiently prepares his bride for their new life together. Go to the Good Friday liturgy and kiss the cross. When you do, let that gesture be the long-awaited "I do" to our faithful God, who always waits for us.

#### **RESPECT LIFE: PRAYER & ACTION**

PRAY: Our Father, 3 Hail Marys, Glory Be

**REFLECT:** The ability to cooperate with God's creative power to conceive and raise a child is one of the most profound gifts that a married couple can receive. Yet sadly, about 1 in 6 people face infertility at some point. For some, the joy of conception never happens. Others suffer repeated miscarriages. Still others experience secondary infertility: after giving birth to one or more children, they experience difficulty having another. When couples are unable to bear children, very often there is an understandable feeling of great loss. It is essential to note that the



Church has true compassion for couples suffering from infertility and wants to be of real help to them. Many causes of infertility can be addressed through medical assistance that is fully in accord with Catholic teaching.

The desire to have a child is beautiful and good. At the same time, we are called to cooperate with God's design for married love and the creation of new life. Some practices, such as in vitro fertilization (IVF) and surrogacy, are not morally legitimate ways to address infertility. In addition to failing to respect the dignity of the couple's marital relationship, of their sexuality, and of the child, some procedures often result in the loss of human life—for example, IVF and surrogacy that involves IVF.

St. John Paul II affirmed to couples who bear the cross of infertility, "you are no less loved by God; your love for each other is complete and fruitful when it is open to others." It is important that all couples who experience infertility—and those who desire to offer them support—know that their love is still fruitful and their married life remains filled with meaning. We pray that couples experiencing infertility will know Christ's closeness in a special way and embrace God's design as they seek to grow their families.

#### **CONTROVERSY OVER IVF**

After a firestorm of controversy surrounding the legality of in vitro fertilization (IVF) in Alabama, the governor signed legislation granting legal immunity to clinics for damaging or destroying embryos. The destruction of embryos (i.e. the killing of innocent pre-born persons) is an ordinary part of the IVF process, and is the chief reason why it should be illegal. IVF would still be gravely wrong even in a hypothetical situation in which no embryos are destroyed, because the process also separates the unitive and procreative goods of sexual activity between a husband and wife.

The controversy was sparked by an Alabama Supreme Court ruling that upheld the wrongful death claims of plaintiff couples whose frozen embryos were accidentally destroyed at an IVF clinic. Both the plaintiffs and the clinic agreed that life begins at conception, which is also enshrined in an amendment to the Alabama constitution and the state's Wrongful Death of a Minor Act, but the clinic claimed an exception should be made for two reasons.


First, the clinic claimed that embryos should be disqualified as "persons" if they exist outside the womb, and second, it claimed that the defendants previously acknowledged the embryos as property instead of persons when they signed the IVF service contract. Significant media attention and public outcry in favor of IVF has resulted, but with little attention paid to the facts of the case or the question of when life and "personhood" begin.






