# SAINT ANTHONY MARY CLARET CATHOLIC CHURCH Baptism Requirements & Certification

## Call the Office Monday - Thursday Only to Schedule the Baptism

1.	Only a Catholic parent or legal guardian can request baptism for a child. The requestor must be a registered member of Saint Anthony Mary Claret Catholic Church, agree to these requirements, and sign the first line below. See the handout Baptism Information at Saint Anthony Mary Claret Church for additional requirements and information.	
2.	If one of the parents is not Catholic, he/she must agree to a Catholic upbringing of the child and sign the second line below.	
3.	Parents & Godparents must attend a Baptism Preparation class prior to having their child baptized. Here at our Parish, the class is held the first Tuesday of the month at 7:30 pm. A certificate of Baptism class attendance from any other Catholic Church is also acceptable.	
	If the Baptism is to take place at another parish, ask for a Baptism Permission Letter.	
4.	A <u>copy</u> of the child's <u>STATE BIRTH CERTIFICATE</u> must be provided before the baptism can be performed.	
5.	The child's Catholic parents are expected to provide a sound Catholic upbringing for their child. A Christian role-model approach by the parents combined with religious education at home and at church are most effective for this purpose.	
6.	At least one Catholic Godparent is required and no more than two (one male and one female) are permitted. The Catholic sponsors will be registered as Godparents. A non-Catholic cannot be recognized as a Godparent and will be registered as a witness only. Godparents must be at least 16 years of age, members in good standing of the Catholic Church, lead a life in harmony with their faith, have received the sacraments of Baptism, First Communion, and Confirmation, and not be the child's parents. See the handout for further information.	
7.	For proposed Godparents who are not registered at St. Anthony Mary Claret Catholic Church, a letter of permission from their Church-of-record is required prior to Baptism.
