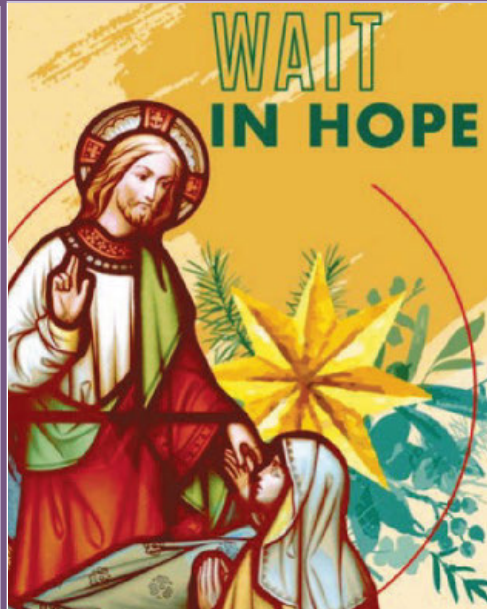

Or maybe someone you love is seriously ill or dying. Name that world or worlds. Then pray: “Lord, help me to not faint with fear. Help me to raise my head and see your redemption coming.”

GOSPEL MEDITATION: LK 21:25-28, 34-36

When I was a young priest, about one year after ordination, I was called to the hospital to anoint a dying mother of three young children. She had a painful, terminal cancer. After celebrating Last Rites with her, I said, “Don’t be afraid.” She looked me square in the eye from her hospital bed and said, “Oh Father, I am in a lot of pain, but I am not afraid. Something wonderful is about to happen.” A few days later she died.

Christians face the ending of our personal various “worlds” in a totally unique way. This first Sunday of Advent, Jesus says that when people see their world falling apart, they find themselves **“fainting with fear and with foreboding of what is coming on the world”** (Luke 21:26). 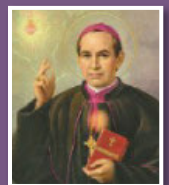

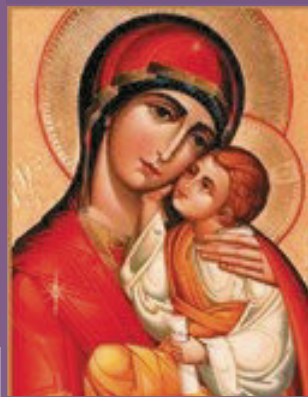

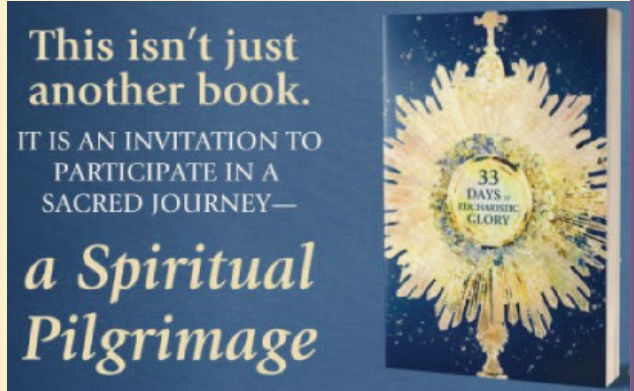

33 DAYS TO EUCHARISTIC GLORY: DEC. 1 - JAN. 5

Sunday, Dec. 1, the first Sunday of Advent, through Jan. 2, our parish will participate in a family spiritual Eucharistic pilgrimage called “33 Days to Eucharistic Glory” based on the book of the same name. This book is being provided to parishioners—*one book per family*—free of charge after Masses this weekend. (Some have already been distributed.) Initial or sign the form to indicate you received it.

It is simple to follow. The book’s introduction explains how the consecration works, then you simply read each of the brief daily readings, 1 – 33, one per day. We pray these short daily meditations done in your home will enrich your family’s love of the Eucharist.



At all Masses Jan. 4 & 5, the Solemnity of the Epiphany, our parish will be consecrated to the Holy Eucharist.
