## GOSPEL MEDITATION: LK 15:1-3, 11-32

I like to imagine the Prodigal Son practicing his apology in the mirror. He wouldn't have, of course. Mirrors weren't exactly a dime a dozen back then. But I imagine him anyway, rehearsing the words as he contemplates his own gaunt reflection: "Father, I have sinned against God and against you. Treat me as you would treat one of your hired workers."

In other words, I have done wrong. I deserve nothing from you. But please, don't let me starve. Save me.

The apology wasn't necessary to move the heart of the father. We know that because before they meet, before

anything is said, the father is overcome with compassion — not because he got his satisfaction, that long-awaited "I'm sorry, I was wrong." No, he's simply overjoyed to see his son alive. Even without apology, we know the father will beg his son to stay. So why does the son apologize?

The father doesn't need the "I'm sorry." He isn't starving and lost. He knew all along it was a bad idea. He doesn't need to learn any lessons.

But what a tragedy it would have been, if the son had never said he was sorry. Undoubtedly, his father would have let him stay as a hired worker, and he would have had food to eat. He would have survived. But he wouldn't have been what he was born to be.

I often think of the son's apology as I am kneeling in the confessional, awkwardly reciting sins God already knows and is eager to forgive. *Why are you doing this?* some people would ask. *God doesn't need this.*

It's the apology, you see. The apology means everything. The Prodigal Son was dead. The apology brought him back to life. God doesn't need our repentance. *We need our repentance.*

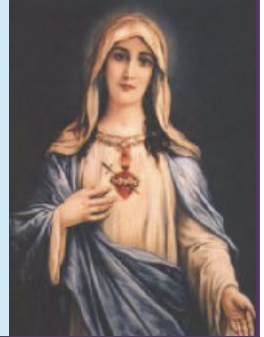

## ON PARTICIPATION IN HOLY MASS & PROPER RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

Please read and observe these very important reminders regarding participation in Holy Mass and proper reception of Holy Communion. Most of you are aware of the following and observe them perfectly, but we have many newcomers to our church who may be unfamiliar with them, thus a review is helpful.

1. Remember to observe the Eucharistic fast by refraining from food and drink (except water or medicine) for at least one hour before receiving Holy Communion.
2. Out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament, please do not receive the Body of Christ while wearing gloves. The Eucharist is the true presence of our Lord, and it is to be received with clean, bare hands or directly on the tongue.
3. When you receive the Body or Blood of Christ, respond with "Amen." Do not say "Thank you," as this is an act of faith.



4. You may receive Holy Communion either on the tongue or in the hand. If receiving on the tongue, open your mouth and extend your tongue outward.

5. When receiving Holy Communion in the hand, place one palm over the other in the form of a cross. If you are consuming with your right hand, receive on your left.

6. After receiving the Body of Christ, do not dip it into the chalice. This helps prevent any risk of the Precious Blood spilling.

7. Consume the Body of Christ immediately after receiving it. Do not carry it away.

8. If you are holding a small child, it is preferable to receive on the tongue to avoid any accidents.

9. Parents, we know how much you love your children and want to share everything with them. However, *the Eucharist is a sacred gift meant for those who have been prepared through First Communion.* If your little ones reach out or ask for it, lovingly explain to them that one day, they too will receive Jesus when the time is right.

10. Whether you receive the Body or the Blood of Christ, you are fully receiving Jesus Christ. The grace of the Eucharist is not dependent on which species you receive.

11. Eating snacks, chewing gum, drinking coffee, tea, soda, etc., during Mass is not appropriate. Let us maintain the sanctity of the Eucharistic celebration.

12. **Participate fully in the Mass from beginning to end.** *Do not leave immediately after Communion.* The final blessing is an essential part of the liturgy.
