

GOSPEL MEDITATION: LK 22:14—23:56

“As he rode along, the people were spreading their cloaks on the road.” — Luke 19:36

Consider how useless it is to spread your clothes on the ground for a donkey to walk on. The clothes get smeared with hooves, and who knows the grimy places where they’ve been? The animal may leave some unsavory presents on them. They may get stolen by a thief looking to make a buck. The thorns, thistles, rocks and muck of the road will leave stains. The clothes may never be useful again, and you’ll probably walk home shivering without your normal covering. Yet this is precisely the gesture the people employ to welcome Jesus and his donkey. Why does this detail matter?


Wastefulness is an essential part of celebration. Consider the unnecessary extravagance of Christmas decorations, confetti and ticker tape parades, baseball players spraying each other with bottles of champagne after a victory, birthday gifts for kids and so on. This wastefulness signals celebration and therefore participation in higher identities (as believers, winners, and parents, as in the above examples). That’s what the wasted cloaks are all about. Those who donate their cloaks participate in Christ’s kingship in Jerusalem — and we savor it two thousand years later.

The lesson? Learn how to “waste” money, time, clothes, and food on Christ. We do this at Mass, but in so many other ways, too, like serving the poor, going on retreats, and doing prayerful study. When we practice this holy wastefulness, Jesus will ride into our lives and we’ll be more deeply members of his kingdom.

ON PARTICIPATION IN HOLY MASS & PROPER RECEPTION OF HOLY COMMUNION

Please read and observe these very important reminders regarding participation in Holy Mass and proper reception of Holy Communion. Most of you are aware of the following and observe them perfectly, but we have many newcomers to our church who may be unfamiliar with them, thus a review is helpful.

1. Remember to observe the Eucharistic fast by refraining from food and drink (except water or medicine) for at least one hour before receiving Holy Communion.
2. Out of reverence for the Blessed Sacrament, please do not receive the Body of Christ while wearing gloves. The Eucharist is the true presence of our Lord, and it is to be received with clean, bare hands or directly on the tongue.
3. When you receive the Body or Blood of Christ, respond with "Amen." Do not say "Thank you," as this is an act of faith.



4. You may receive Holy Communion either on the tongue or in the hand. If receiving on the tongue, open your mouth and extend your tongue outward.

5. When receiving Holy Communion in the hand, place one palm over the other in the form of a cross. If you are consuming with your right hand, receive on your left.

6. After receiving the Body of Christ, do not dip it into the chalice. This helps prevent any risk of the Precious Blood spilling.

7. Consume the Body of Christ immediately after receiving it. Do not carry it away.

8. If you are holding a small child, it is preferable to receive on the tongue to avoid any accidents.

9. Parents, we know how much you love your children and want to share everything with them. However, *the Eucharist is a sacred gift meant for those who have been prepared through First Communion.* If your little ones reach out or ask for it, lovingly explain to them that one day, they too will receive Jesus when the time is right.

10. Whether you receive the Body or the Blood of Christ, you are fully receiving Jesus Christ. The grace of the Eucharist is not dependent on which species you receive.

11. Eating snacks, chewing gum, drinking coffee, tea, soda, etc., during Mass is not appropriate. Let us maintain the sanctity of the Eucharistic celebration.

12. **Participate fully in the Mass from beginning to end.** *Do not leave immediately after Communion.* The final blessing is an essential part of the liturgy.

Our parish's Two Hearts Charismatic Prayer Group invites you to join them on a Holy Thursday pilgrimage!



Every Holy Thursday, groups of Catholic faithful across the country and world embark on what's known as the Seven Churches Visitation. In this special tradition, pilgrims adore Christ in seven different altars of repose while praying and reflecting on the Passion of Christ. At the end of each Holy Thursday Mass, the priest strips the altar and removes the Eucharist from the tabernacle to place it in repose on another nearby altar. The Seven Churches Visitation (or Pilgrimage) is credited as beginning in Rome with St. Philip Neri in the 1500s. Neri would lead groups of faithful to visit

each of the seven basilicas of Rome on Holy Thursday night as a way of keeping watch with Christ as though at the Garden of Gethsemane before His Passion. Today, the devotion is primarily practiced in Latin America, Italy, Poland, and the Philippines. Each visit calls on the faithful to reflect on the seven final places Jesus went from his arrest on Holy Thursday to his death on Good Friday. At each church, pilgrims kneel before the altar of repose, meditate on a scriptural excerpt, and offer prayers and adoration.

After a short visit with Jesus in Msgr. Hubertus Hall, the prayer group will gather in front of the hall near their blue banner to hand out prayers and maps to the seven churches they will be visiting. You may choose to carpool or follow the others to each church.


